

Creating Your Christmas Eve Ornament:

Contents:

- Cross
- Wooden disc (with sticker on back)
- Shoelace
- Glitter
- Wooden Alpha and Omega
- Tacky glue
- Brush (to apply glue)



Instructions:

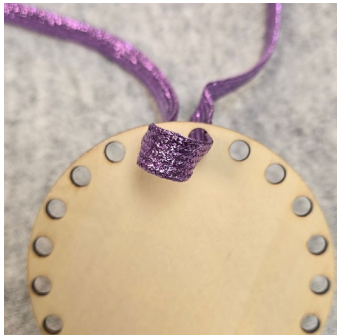
- Use the brush to 'paint' a thin layer of glue on the front only of the Alpha and the Omega.
- Sprinkle glitter on the letters
- Lightly tap letters to remove excess glitter and set aside to dry
- Lace shoelace around wooden disc

Fold lace in half

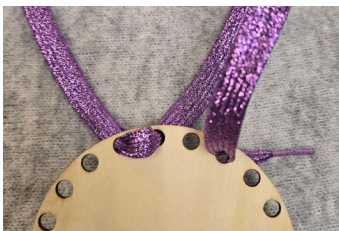


Find top of ornament (based on sticker on back).

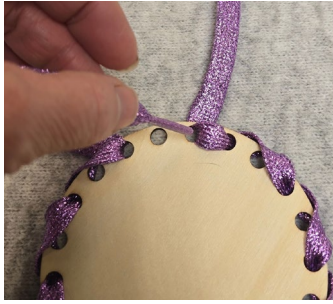
Push each end through one of the top two holes from front to back of ornament (evenly, but do not pull tight because you will need to feed laces back through this front loop)



Start with lace on the right and wrap it around to the front, looping it through the 2nd hole from front to back



Continue this process all the way around the ornament skipping one hole as you lace until you get back to the top of the ornament



Do the same with the other half of the lace always wrapping around and inserting the lace into the open holes from the front of the ornament to the back (Working in the same direction as the first time)



Wrap each of the laces to the front and feed through the initial loose loop (the one you made when you first inserted the lace into the ornament) from bottom to top



Tie the two ends together to make a hanging loop



- Apply glue to one side of the cross and adhere it to the wooden disk (note the loop at the top and align cross accordingly).
- Once the letters are dry, apply glue to the back of the letters and adhere them to the disc on either side of the cross.
