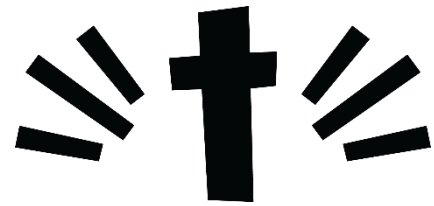


BRING IT HOME

John 6

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

What does it mean for Jesus to be the "bread of life"?

How can we grow in our understanding of God's Word?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Work with your kids to bake a loaf of bread. Talk to your kids about the ways Jesus sustains us and satisfies the spiritual hunger of our souls for God's truth.

September 13

Three Parables

Luke 15

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why did Jesus heal people and do miracles?

What was the most important miracle Jesus did?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Play a game of hide-and-seek with your kids. Discuss the ways our sin leads us away from God. Remind kids that Jesus is like the seeker.

September 27

Jesus Raised Lazarus

John 11

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

What does it mean for Jesus to be "the resurrection and the life"?

How can Christians feel joy even in the middle of sad times?

FAMILY ACTIVITY-

Work with your family to prepare and deliver a care package to someone in your church who has experienced a recent loss. Pray that the Lord will provide comfort and peace. Discuss the hope Jesus gives.
