WEEKLY FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS & ACTIVITIES:

April 4

Jesus' Crucifixion and Resurrection

Matthew 26-28; John 20

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why did Jesus have to die on the cross?
Who raised Jesus from the dead?
How can people be forgiven of their sins?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

As you participate in whatever Easter traditions your family enjoys, talk to your kids about the reason we celebrate Easter. Invite them to write praises to God for His love and forgiveness.

The Hall of Faith

Hebrews 11

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Who do you know that has strong faith?
Why do you think God promises us good things?
How can we remain faithful to God?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

Complete a trust fall style activity with your kids. Use cushions and padded gear to ensure safety. Talk about the importance of trusting God in uncertain times.

April 18

Peter Escaped From Prison

Acts 12

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why did the church pray for Peter?
Who can we pray for?
What should we do if God doesn't answer our prayers the way we want Him to?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

Walk with your family through your neighborhood, praying for the people who live in your community. Take time to share encouraging words with anyone you meet.

April 25

Paul's First Journey

Acts 13-14

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why is it important to share the gospel with everyone?
How should we respond when people reject Jesus?
What kinds of difficulties might we face for sharing the gospel?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

Gather lots of coins. Work with your kids to sort the coins by different qualities, such as color, size, or value. Discuss God's love for all people despite differences.
