


BRING IT HOME

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Who are some people that you struggle to get along with?

How can you show love to those people?

Why do you think God unites all kinds of people through Jesus?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Lead your kids in kitchen experiments. Try to find unexpected food combinations that actually taste good. Discuss God's plans to unite all kinds of people.

Letters to Church Leaders

1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

What does it take to be a good church leader?

Who are the leaders in your church?

How can you love and support the leaders in your church?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Look for opportunities throughout the week to encourage your kids to take on small leadership roles, such as leading the prayer before bedtime, planning what to make for dinner, and so forth.

May 16

Paul's Second Journey

Acts 15-18

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why do you think Paul and Silas worshiped in prison?

How can we worship God in hard times?

Why doesn't God need anything from people?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Research a local prison ministry. Help your kids write encouraging notes or draw pictures that could be delivered to prisoners who are being reached by the ministry.

May 23

No Other Gospel

Galatians 1-3

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Why does God want us to grow in godliness?

How does faith help us grow in godliness?

Where does our power to obey come from?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Go on a nighttime walk using flashlights to see. Ask your kids what would happen if you removed the batteries. Explain that just as batteries are needed to turn the light on and keep it on, faith is how we are saved and how we grow.

May 30

Paul Gave Hope

1-2 Thessalonians

DISCUSSION STARTERS:

Who knows when Jesus will return?

How can we be ready for Jesus' return?

Why do believers have hope even when we feel sad about death?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Go cloud watching with your kids. Challenge your family to find clouds that look like specific shapes. Ten, remind your kids that the Bible says Jesus will come back through the clouds, just as He ascended.
