

Bring it Home OCT. 2020

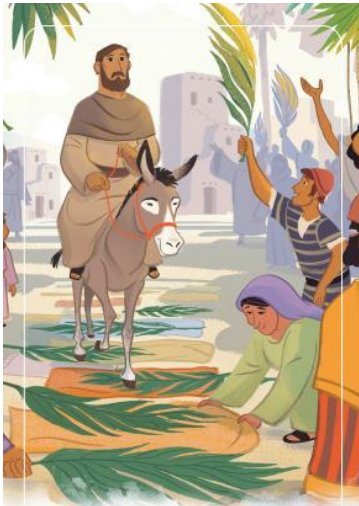
The conversation starter you need to continue at home what began at Immanuel. Our desire is to see families use this resource as you live out Deuteronomy 11:19.

Big Picture Question: What did Jesus do to save us?

Jesus lived a sinless life, died on the cross, and rose from the dead.

KEY PASSAGE: Philippians 2:8 (ESV)

...And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

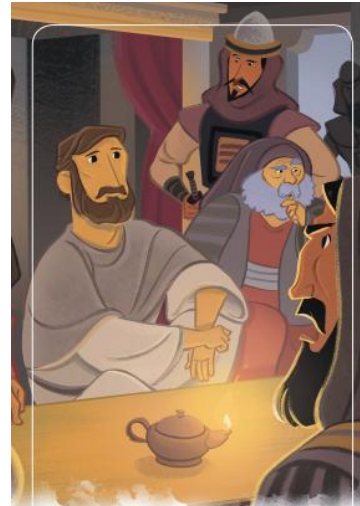


Jesus' Triumphal Entry
Matthew 21 Mark 11 Luke 19 John 12



Key Passage: Philippians 2:8
Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection: Jesus is the King who rescues His people.
Preschool Christ Connection: The people were happy to see Jesus. They knew He was their King. Jesus came riding on a donkey, just as the prophet Zechariah said He would. (Zechariah 9:9) One day, Jesus will come back, riding on a white horse as King over everything. (Revelation 19:11)
Big Picture Question & Answer: What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead.
Story Point for Babies & Toddlers: Jesus died to rescue us.
Story Point for Preschoolers: People welcomed Jesus as their King.
Gospel Gems:

- Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey.
- People welcomed Jesus as their King.
- God sent Jesus to earth because He loves us.



Jesus Was Questioned
Matthew 22 Mark 12 Luke 20



Key Passage: Philippians 2:8
Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection: Jesus spoke with wisdom that comes from God.
Preschool Christ Connection: When the religious leaders asked Jesus questions, He answered with wisdom. Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. He came to show us what God is like. Jesus has power in heaven and on earth.
Big Picture Question & Answer: What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead.
Story Point for Babies & Toddlers: Jesus died to rescue us.
Story Point for Preschoolers: Jesus spoke with wisdom.
Gospel Gems:

- Some teachers tried to trick Jesus.
- Jesus answered with wisdom.
- Jesus told the people that He is the Messiah, the Son of God.



The Last Supper
Matthew 26 Mark 14 Luke 22 John 13



Key Passage: Philippians 2:8
Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection: Jesus made a new, even better covenant.
Preschool Christ Connection: God made a covenant, or agreement, with His people long ago. The people promised to love and obey God, and He promised to be their God. Sadly, God's people broke the covenant. God sent Jesus to make a new, even better covenant. God would forgive people for their sins, and God would help them obey Him.
Big Picture Question & Answer: What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead.
Story Point for Babies & Toddlers: Jesus died to rescue us.
Story Point for Preschoolers: Jesus told His disciples to remember Him.
Gospel Gems:

- Jesus ate a special meal with His friends.
- Jesus told His friends about God's plan.
- Jesus told His friends to remember what He did for them.



Jesus Was Arrested
Matthew 26-27



Key Passage: Philippians 2:8
Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection: Jesus obeyed His Father's plan no matter what.
Preschool Christ Connection: Jesus knew God's plan was for Him to die to rescue people from sin. Jesus' friends left Him and He was arrested, but Jesus did not fight back. He wanted to do His Father's plan no matter what.
Big Picture Question & Answer: What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead.
Story Point for Babies & Toddlers: Jesus died to rescue us.
Story Point for Preschoolers: Jesus was arrested though He did nothing wrong.
Gospel Gems:

- Jesus went to a garden to pray.
- People arrested Jesus, but He did nothing wrong.
- Jesus said everything happened as God planned.
