The conversation starter you need to continue at home what began at Immanuel. Our desire is to see families use this resource as you live out Deuteronomy 11:19.

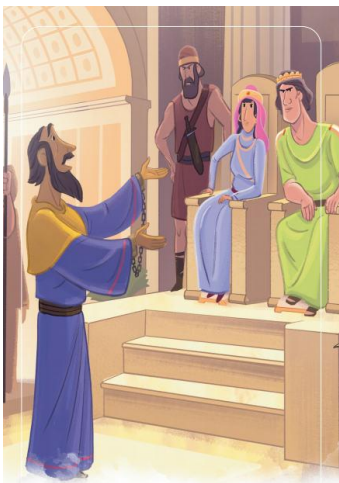
## Big Picture Question: What will happen for all Christians in the future?

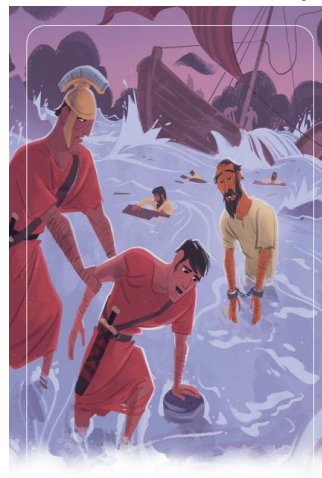
**Paul Before Rulers**  
Acts 24-26



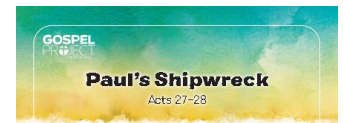
**Key Passage:** Philippians 1:6  
**Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection:** God wants all people to hear the truth about Jesus.  
**Preschool Christ Connection:** God chose Paul to tell all kinds of people—even kings—about Jesus. Even when people were against him, Paul did not stop. He wanted everyone to believe that Jesus is Lord. Paul believed Jesus has the power to save people from sin, and he was willing to do anything to share this good news.  
**Big Picture Question & Answer:** What will happen for all Christians in the future? One day all Christians will see Jesus in His glory and live with Him forever.  
**Story Point for Babies & Toddlers:** One day all Christians will see Jesus.  
**Story Point for Preschoolers:** Paul told rulers about Jesus.  
**Gospel Gems:**

- People put Paul in prison.
- Governors asked Paul questions about Jesus.
- Paul taught about Jesus no matter what.

July 11th



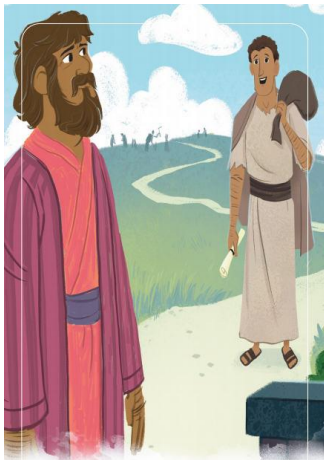
**Paul's Shipwreck**  
Acts 27-28



**Key Passage:** Philippians 1:6  
**Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection:** Jesus died to keep us safe from sin and death.  
**Preschool Christ Connection:** Paul trusted God's promise to keep him and everyone else safe from the storm. He told the sailors to trust God too. God wants us to trust Jesus. Jesus died to keep us safe from sin and death. We can tell this good news to everyone.  
**Big Picture Question & Answer:** What will happen for all Christians in the future? One day all Christians will see Jesus in His glory and live with Him forever.  
**Story Point for Babies & Toddlers:** One day all Christians will see Jesus.  
**Story Point for Preschoolers:** Paul trusted God to keep him safe.  
**Gospel Gems:**

- Paul was taken on a boat to Rome.
- A storm broke apart Paul's boat, but God kept him safe.
- Nothing could stop God's plan for Paul.

July 18th



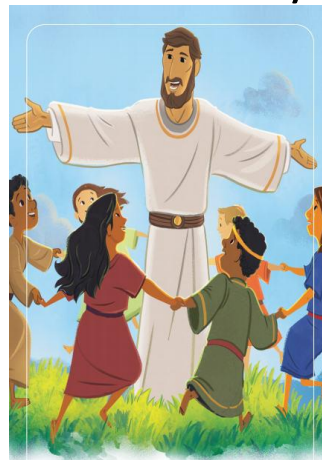
**Brothers in Christ**  
Philemon



**Key Passage:** Philippians 1:6  
**Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection:** Jesus came to make peace between God and people.  
**Preschool Christ Connection:** Paul asked Philemon to show kindness to Onesimus and treat him like a brother in Jesus. He wanted to make peace between his friends. In this way, Paul acted like Jesus. Jesus came into the world to make peace between God and people. He died on the cross for our sin so we can be part of God's family forever.  
**Big Picture Question & Answer:** What will happen for all Christians in the future? One day all Christians will see Jesus in His glory and live with Him forever.  
**Story Point for Babies & Toddlers:** One day all Christians will see Jesus.  
**Story Point for Preschoolers:** Paul wanted to make peace between his friends.  
**Gospel Gems:**

- Paul told Onesimus to return to Philemon.
- Paul asked Philemon to show kindness to Onesimus.
- Jesus wants us to do what is right because we love Him.

**Children of God**  
1 John 2-3



**Key Passage:** Philippians 1:6  
**Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection:** Because Jesus gave His life for us, we give our lives for others.  
**Preschool Christ Connection:** John's letter taught believers—children of God—that showing love is so important. Love is more than feelings or words; love is something you do. Jesus showed God's love for us when He died on the cross to take our punishment for sin.  
**Big Picture Question & Answer:** What will happen for all Christians in the future? One day all Christians will see Jesus in His glory and live with Him forever.  
**Story Point for Babies & Toddlers:** One day all Christians will see Jesus.  
**Story Point for Preschoolers:** People who are God's children love one another.  
**Gospel Gems:**

- People who love Jesus are part of God's family.
- God wants us to love one another.
- We know what love is because Jesus gave His life for us.
