BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- As Jesus traveled toward Jerusalem, someone asked, “Lord, are only a few people going to be saved?”
- Jesus said that the path to heaven is like a narrow door and not everyone will enter. Only people who trust in Jesus can enter.
- Jesus wept over Jerusalem because He knew He would be rejected and killed there.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Everyone is invited into the kingdom of God, but not everyone will enter. People are saved only by trusting in Jesus. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Him.

KEY PASSAGE: Isaiah 53:3

He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

Why do people reject Jesus? People reject Jesus because all people are born with a sin nature and want to please themselves rather than obey God.
