WHAT IS REPENTANCE? REPENTANCE IS TURNING AWAY FROM SIN AND TURNING TO JESUS.

Jesus and His disciples were approaching the great city of Jerusalem. He sent two of the disciples ahead, saying you will find a young donkey, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it.

They went ahead and found it just as Jesus had told them. When the owners said, "Why are you untying the donkey?", they replied, "The Lord needs it."

This took place so that the prophecy would be fulfilled that says, "See, your King is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey."

The two disciples brought the donkey to Jesus and helped Jesus get on it. As He was going along, a large crowd of people spread their clothes on the road and cut palm branches from trees to place on the road as well. They said, "Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

Some of the Pharisees asked Jesus to tell the people to be quiet. Jesus replied, "If they were to keep silent, the stones would cry out."

As Jesus approached the city, He cried for it. He was sad for the people because of the consequences that would come for not recognizing Him as God and Savior.

The Pharisees saw the way the people praised Jesus as King because they had seen Him do miracles. They said, "We have accomplished nothing to stop the people from following Jesus. The world has gone after Him!"


