

[ih-kwip]

verb (used with object), equipped, equipping.

- 1. to furnish or provide with whatever is needed for use or for any undertaking
- 2. to furnish with intellectual or emotional resources; to prepare

Being Well-Equipped by God

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, EQUIPPED for every good work.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 English Standard Version (ESV)

 Context - Paul is reflecting on the true character of the Scriptures and their value to him in ministry.

 God's written word is authoritative simply because it is <u>God's</u> Word.

- For reproof & correction –
 we discipline, we make paths straight
- For training in righteousness wisdom, maturity, discernment

Be still and know I am God. Psalm 46:10

- Be receptive to His voice
- Expect that God has something to tell you


